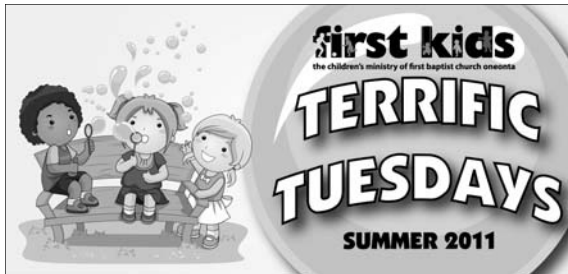


Announcements

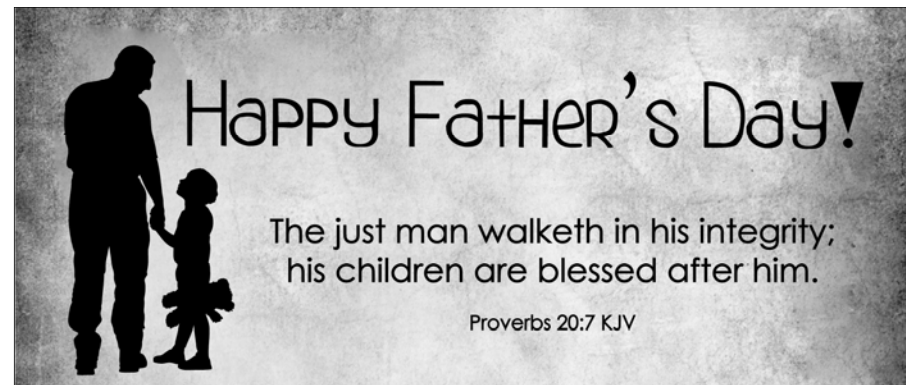

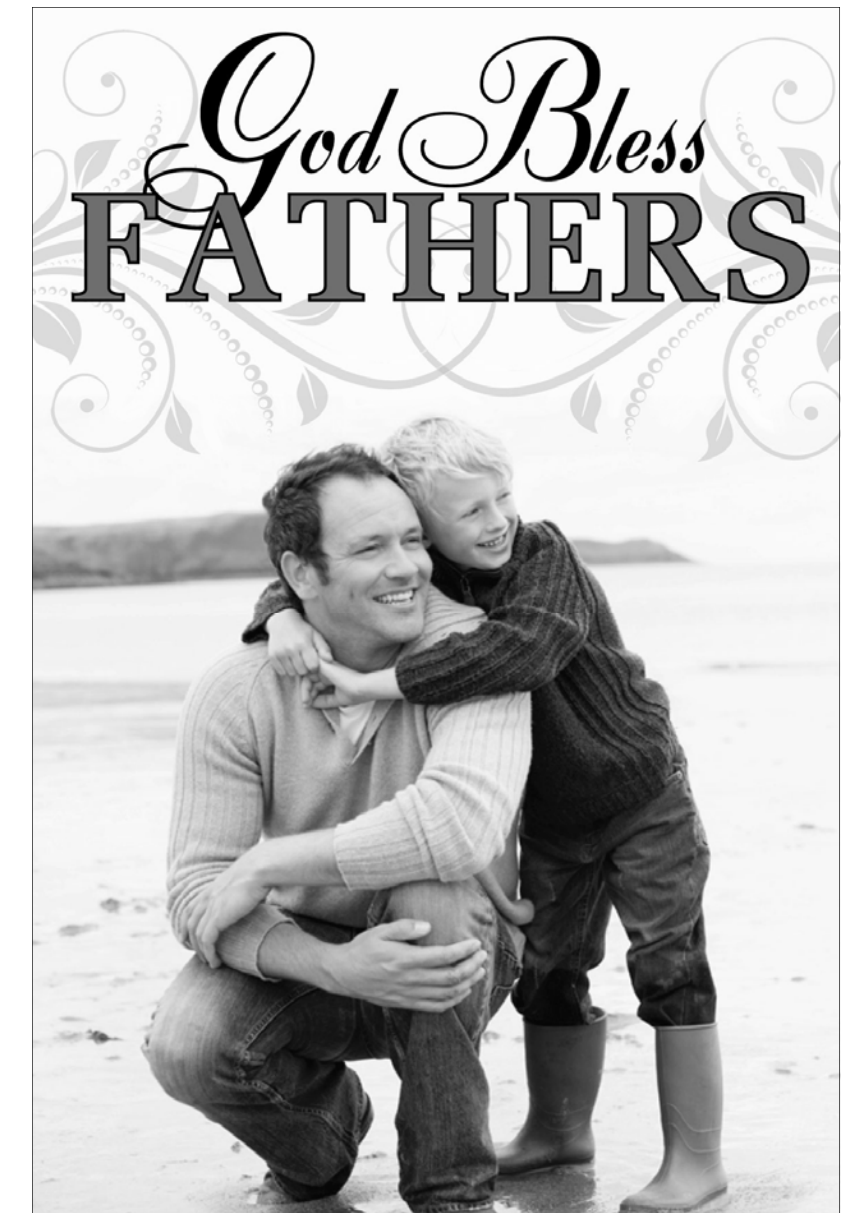
