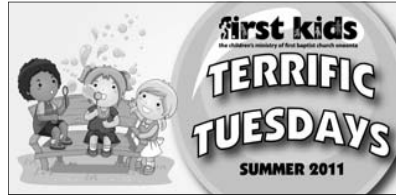


Announcements
