

## BRO. LARRY'S SERMON NOTES

**Title:** Christians Must Be Affected by Sermons

**Text:** Matthew 7:24-29

**Review:** Today is the last message in our Sermon on the Mount series; therefore, let's briefly review where we have been so far.

- The Sermon on the Mount is one of the most written about portions of Scripture.
- The Sermon on the Mount is the longest teaching of Jesus recorded in the Bible.
- The Sermon on the Mount is not only one of the most well-known sections of Scripture but it is also one of the most misunderstood. We won't go over any of these misinterpretations right now, but we saw that a true interpretation of the Sermon involves three truths.
  1. This was the part of Jesus' message about the good news of the kingdom of God.
  2. True righteousness is a matter of the heart.
  3. Jesus was teaching us that this is how a disciple of Jesus lives.

Now as we come to the final section, Jesus draws all of the themes to a close with a powerful, brief compelling story about two builders and their houses.
