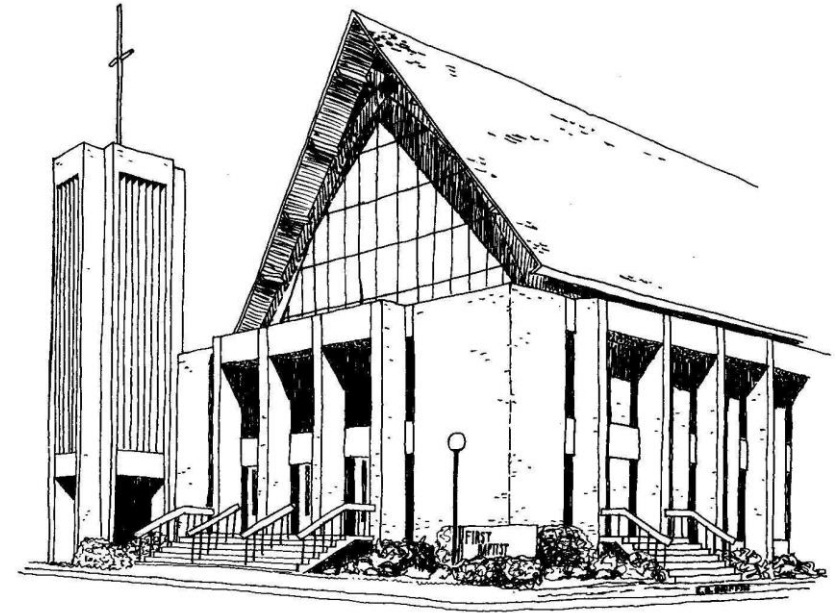

NEW SERMON SERIES

What is important about October 31st? Most of us would answer that it is Halloween. Indeed it is; however, it is also "Reformation Day." What is that and how did it come about in history? The Protestant Reformation was a widespread theological revolt in Europe against the abuses and totalitarian control of the Roman Catholic Church. Reformers, such as Martin Luther in Germany, Ulrich Zwingli in Switzerland, and John Calvin in France, protested various unbiblical practices of the Catholic Church and promoted a return to sound biblical doctrine. The precipitating event of the Protestant Reformation is generally considered to be Luther's posting of his Ninety-five Theses (Complaints) on the door of the Wittenberg Church on October 31, 1517. Hence, "Reformation Day."

At the heart of the Protestant Reformation lay four basic questions: How is a person saved? Where does religious authority lie? What is the church? What is the essence of Christian living? In answering these questions, Protestant Reformers developed what would be known as the "Five Solas" (sola being the Latin word for "alone"). These five essential points of biblical doctrine clearly separate Protestantism from Roman Catholicism. The Reformers resisted the demands placed on them to recant these doctrines, even to the point of death.

On this five hundredth anniversary of the Reformation (1517-2017), a sermon series entitled "**These Things We Believe**" will be preached each Sunday beginning on October 29th in the morning service through November 26th. A series like this will help us to understand clearly the basic beliefs we have as Protestants.
