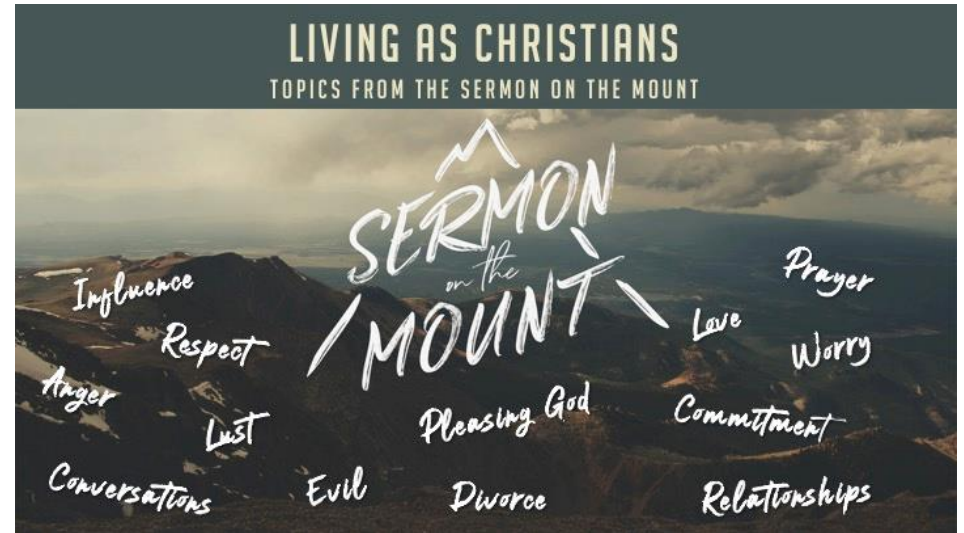


Title: Christians Must Pay Attention to Their Conversations

Text: Matthew 5:33-37

Introduction: We live in a world of words! Let's think of how many words come to us each day of our lives. Thousands of words occur in daily conversations. Numerous printed words come to us in many forms. Social media, radio, and television bombards us with words. In some cases, words have become meaningless. Commercial advertisements and perjury in courts has become commonplace; and often, words of leaders are no longer trusted!

Jesus placed a supreme importance on His follower's use of words. He spoke in the Sermon on the Mount of the higher righteousness of His followers. Six times Jesus quoted the provision of the old law, and six times He said, "But I tell you." In regard to conversation, the old law said, "No false swearing." Jesus said, "Do not swear at all." Jesus discussed the matter of a Christian conversation by means of a striking contrast. What is the contrast?
