

Title: Christians Worship to Please God

Text: Matthew 6:1-18

Introduction: Worship was very important to Jesus! We should conclude that during all the years before our Lord began His public ministry, He was very consistent in His habits of both public and private worship. "He went to Nazareth where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read" (Luke 4:16). Perhaps, the way we would write this verse today would be, "On Sunday He went to church, as was His custom, to read Scripture and to worship His Heavenly Father!"

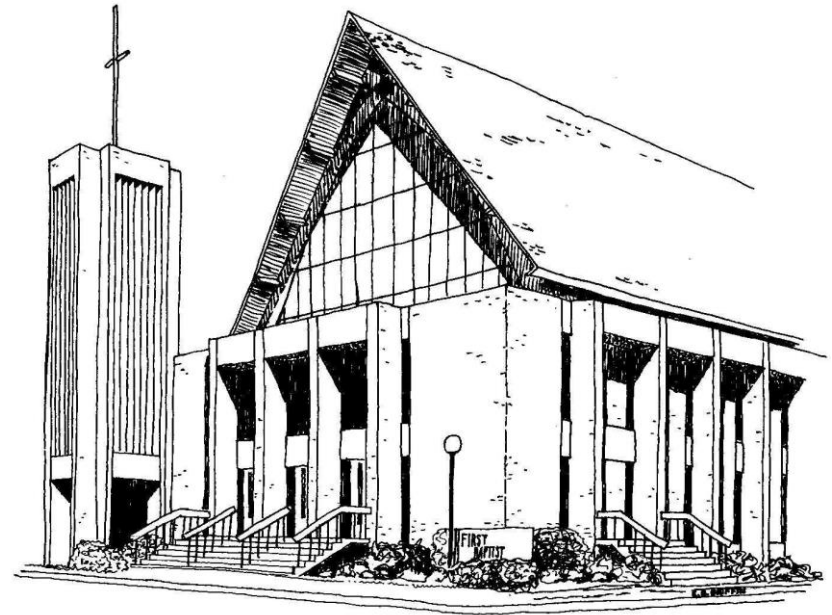
Once Jesus began His public ministry, worship was a priority too. Here in the Sermon on the Mount, He discussed three elements which are part of true Christian worship. As He did with righteousness, Jesus anchored worship in the heart. Worship is not something to be done *for men*. Worship is something to be done *to God*. (6:1)
