Title: Glorious Promises of God to His Children

Text: Isaiah 41:10


Introduction: I have heard that there are 365 "fear nots" in the Bible, one for every day of the year. What a source of hope and confidence it would be to begin each and every day by meditating on the fact that we don't have to fear whatever we have to face.

Much to my chagrin, "fear not," nor any of its close derivates (fear thou not, be not afraid, do not fear, etc.), can be found in God's Word 365 times. This information is not earthshaking. It's just a cute saying that seems to be to this point incorrect. Don't let it shake your faith. Just do not fear!

However, regardless of how many times we are instructed not to fear, it is our human tendency to fear. After all, there are many reasons to fear today: Coronavirus (COVID-19), economic collapse, recession, sickness, possible loss of a job, uncertainty of the future, etc.

As we are wrestling with this emotional issue, let's be reminded that God desires for us to walk by faith, not fear! Fear and faith are opposites. God gives the gift of faith, not a spirit of fear. "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9) "For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline." (2 Timothy 1:7, NIV) "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind." (2 Timothy 1:7, NKJV) In our text for today, Isaiah tells us, "don't fear." Why? Because God promises to protect us. Let's notice this five-fold promise.
